Manitoba Geological Survey 2019 Overview

ABSTRACT

This overview outlines the Manitoba Geological Survey's 2019 program, including the broad range of independent, partnered and collaborative geoscience initiatives undertaken this year. The differing scales and diversity of these projects reflect the Survey's aptitude to tackle complex geological problems posed by Manitoba's diverse geology.

The presentation emphasizes on the Survey's priority to build and maintain a comprehensive and authoritative geoscience infrastructure that is effective and accessible to all stakeholders, and provides avenues for partnerships and the sustainable development of Manitoba's mineral and energy resources.
